



CALL FOR STUDENT POSTERS

The Delaware Psychological Association (DPA) invites graduate students in psychology to present poster summaries at its 2016 annual convention to be held on Friday, October 21 and Saturday, October 22, 2016 at the Hyatt in Dewey. The poster session is scheduled for Friday, October 21, from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Posters may report on empirical (quantitative or qualitative) studies or non-empirical theoretical/review projects. The poster session allows for extended discussion of the presentation with the author. Authors use illustrative materials, showing tables, graphs and data, placed on a poster board that is sturdy enough to support its own weight on a standard easel. **Authors must provide their own poster board.** DPA will provide easels for exhibiting posters.

Poster presenters may begin setting up at 5:30 p.m. on Friday, October 21st and are invited to join DPA for dinner following their presentations. If you would like to come down to Rehoboth earlier in the day on Friday and attend a portion of our continuing education program, please let us know on your poster submission. We will try to accommodate your request if there is available seating.

Proposal Submission Requirements and Instructions:

1. Please submit your poster proposal to DPA via e-mail, **no later than Monday, October 3, 2016**, to Mary Marceluk dpa@depsych.org.

Your e-mail submission must contain the following information:

- Your full name and current degree;
 - Name of your university and field of study
 - Your mailing address
 - Your telephone number
 - Your e-mail address
 - The title and a brief one or two paragraph summary of your poster presentation
2. Students will receive an e-mail from DPA confirming the receipt and acceptance of their poster proposal and providing detailed information about and directions to the convention.
